Bright raspberry, cherry, and light floral notes highlight the structured offering of bold rip flavor and robust power in this wine. Dark ripe plum is seasoned with tobacco and leather. It has lasting richness to the finish.

This balanced zinfandel pairs well with a variety of dishes such as spicy baby back ribs, classic BBQ fare, rich mole sauces, and pasta with red sauce. This wine is also excellent on its own.
