TASTING NOTES

Complex and bright, this sauvignon blanc displays prominent aromas of citrus, stone fruits and orange blossoms. The palate is indicative of traditional Bordeaux winemaking techniques and the exceptional fruit sourced from the Sonoma Coast, with fresh flavors of nectarine, ripe pear and white peach. The finish is crisp and clean, with a touch of mandarin and dried apricot.

This wine is great match for a variety of food pairings like roasted artichoke salad with lemon and mint, delicate white fish like petrale sole, and spicy Asian dishes. This refreshing sauvignon blanc is also delicious on its own.
