This cool-climate Pinot Noir is a tribute to the excellent 2019 vintage. Bursting with bright red fruit aromatics laced with cherry cola and sweet tea notes. Medium-bodied, with lush characteristics of raspberry, cranberry, and cherry pie. Drink now through 2028.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRING

A go-to, effortless everyday pinot, this wine pairs easily. Serve with simple cheese and charcuterie, wood-fired pizza, or roasted pork or chicken. Pinot noir pairs with earthy flavors, like mushrooms and truffles, and light garden dishes, such as sundried tomato pesto with summer squash and basil.
