TASTING NOTES

Aromas of wildflower honey and ripe apricot are complemented by baking spice. This wine is balanced with stone fruit flavors as well as a rich, creamy brioche with hints of nutmeg spice on the palate. An appetizing layer of subtle acidity balances out the full mouth feel.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRING

A full-bodied white, this wine is excellent with rich shellfish or poultry dishes. Try this wine with Moroccan-spiced chicken or steamed clams and mussels in a white wine butter sauce with plenty of sourdough bread.
