Tasting Notes: Aromas of crisp green apple and subtle citrus come together in this fresh, light-bodied wine. A sparkling acidity is complimented by honeydew melon, white peach, and almond.

Anniversary Cuvée

30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 27% Cabernet Franc, 21% Merlot, 14% Syrah, 8% Petit Verdot

Tasting Notes: Aromas of dark berries and sun-ripen plums showcase this full bodied wine. Complex layers of subtle Porcini mushrooms and soft black pepper spice complement the notes of ripe raspberry. Smooth integrated tannins lead to a long graceful finish. Drink now through 2030.

2019 Rivertrace GSM (Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre)

25% Mourvèdre, 30% Grenache, 33% Syrah, 12% Carignane

Tasting Notes: Aromas of blackberry, black cherry, herbs de Provence, and mocha on the nose evolve into vibrant flavors of red cherry, cranberry, and Schezuan pepper on the palate. The body and acidity are well balanced and moderate, and the finish lingers.

2018 Cabernet Franc

Tasting Notes: Features aromas of black cherries, wet earth, eucalyptus, and pink peppercorns. The palate is precise, layered flavors of wild berries, fennel, spice, and a hint of savoriness, finishing with a hint of cocoa nibs.

Tasting Notes: This elegant and delicate wine features aromas of sweet stone fruit, jasmine, and citrus flowers, with a touch of butterscotch and vanilla bean. The finish has flavors of pear and tropical papaya, framed by subtle acidity.

Tasting Notes: Lucious notes of pear, white peach, and orange blossom are framed by suggestions of tropical fruit and citrus on the palate. The mouthfeel is unctuous, with a soft extended finish laced with bright acidity.
