TASTING NOTES

Apricot and guava with hints of orange blossom and jasmine on the nose lead into intense flavors of apricot, white peach, and crème brûlée with a subtle hint of oak on the finish.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRING

This wine is excellent paired with soft and semisoft cheeses such as fresh chèvre, gruyere, aged Gouda, and triple creams like Cowgirl Creamery's Mt. Tam. Another excellent pairing would be with a main course of shrimps or scallops, for instance seared scallops with bacon marmalade.
