TASTING NOTES

Light gold in color, this wine offers quince paste, honey, and ripe apricot aromas. It is balanced with stone fruit flavors as well as a rich, creamy brioche with hints of nutmeg spice on the palate. An appetizing layer of subtle acidity balances out the full mouth feel.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRING

This wine is excellent with rich shellfish dishes and salmon with lemon and herbs. Try this with steamed clams and mussels in a white wine butter sauce, and plenty of sourdough bread.
