TASTING NOTES

This balanced and elegant Cabernet Sauvignon showcases aromas of black cherry, nutmeg, and sandalwood, followed by earthy forest floor, dried sage, and secondary floral notes. Cranberry, fine leather, and espresso lead on the palate. A subtle herbaceousness and minerality bolster its richness, while close-grained tannins provide structure. Drink now through 2027.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRING

The 2018 Louvau Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon pairs well with bold, umami flavors like steak and mushrooms. Try it with strong cheese, like blue or Gorgonzola, and charcuterie. This wine is also a perfect choice to serve on its own, as it evolves beautifully in the glass.
