TASTING NOTES

Despite unpredictable weather, the 2019 vintage was a perfect "storm" of growing conditions in the Napa Valley. Our 2019 Napa Cabernet is true to vintage, showcasing stellar fruit concentration, ample acidity, and depth. Upfront aromatics offer suggestions of boysenberry jam, elderberry, plum, anise seed and vanilla bean. The mouth-feel is smooth despite the firm tannins, and the finish is extended and laden with cocoa, black pepper and leather. This is sure to improve with age; best now through 2029.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRING

This versatile, food friendly wine pairs well with traditional main courses such as steaks and braised short ribs. Try serving with your favorite comfort food such as meatloaf, polenta with Bolognese, or beef pot pies.
